The response to the boat parade has been overwhelming. For those of you who want to do it the generator you will need to run 120 Volt lights is a 1000W gnerator with the designation of "quiet" somewhere in the description. Although Honda sells one for \$785.00 (EU1000), I took Pinky's advice and went to Ebay where I found a "like" \$250.00 (Pheeuw! 1000) off brand model (New, can't pronounce the name). At \$250.00 the pain of going overboard with it in your hand at full wattage is about the same as the Honda, but you're just not out as much money. Read any ad well before buying to make sure you don't have to buy anything extra (like the motor or something).

Go Ebay, type in GENERATORS, wait for the 875 selections to come up. The one you are looking for is very small, makes no noise, holds about .6 gallons of gas and runs for a minimum of 3 hours under load and 8 hours no load. You just don't want your generator to be louder than your music, it'll ruin your day and put your little pirate shorts in a wad.

NOTE: any connections on your boat are probably 12 volt (unless you own a Mega yacht like slimshady) so you will have to find 12 volt lights. I'm note sure of the availability of those.

Stringing: Pinky and I are working on a way to

connect the lights along the bump rail on our boats with some sort of clip so we don't harm the boat in any way. We're open to ideas but keep your hands off of our Grog.
